

ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on the Second Request for Motion of Continuance (Doc. No.), filed by Relief Defendant, Darren Lee. Therein Darren Lee asserts that Plaintiffs have not responded to certain discovery requests that he propounded upon them, and as a result, he apparently seeks to avoid the trial on damages and civil penalties currently scheduled for November 8, 2010. Darren Lee does not indicate that he intends to request that

the Court compel the Plaintiffs to respond to his discovery¹, nor does he indicate when, if ever, he anticipates that he would be prepared to proceed with trial. Because Darren Lee has failed to provide an adequate basis for delay of this trial, the Request for Motion for Continuance is DENIED.
