

ORDER

Before the Court is Relief Defendant Darren Lee's motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal [Doc. No. 155]. To proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal, Darren Lee must show that his appeal is taken in good faith and that he lacks the financial ability to pay the required appellate fees. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1) & (a)(3). Having reviewed his motion and financial declaration, the Court finds that Darren Lee lacks the financial ability to pay the required fees. However, the Court finds that his appeal is not taken in good faith because he has

not shown the existence of a reasoned, non-frivolous argument on the law and facts in support of the issues raised on appeal. *DeBardleben v. Quinlan*, 937 F.2d 502, 505 (10th Cir. 1991). Specifically the Court notes that Darren Lee failed to either file a response to Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment or to appear for trial. Accordingly, Darren Lee's motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal [Doc. No. 155] is DENIED.
