

ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

On June 29, 2004, a recommendation to issue an order to cease and desist (Recommendation) against A1 Tech Marketing and Amir Elias was filed with the Administrator of the Oklahoma Department of Securities (Department). The issuance of such order is authorized by Section 814(B) of the Oklahoma Business Opportunity Sales Act ("Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 801-829 (2001).

On June 29, 2004, the Administrator of the Department issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing with the Recommendation attached (Notice). Pursuant to Section 818(F) of the Act, the Notice was served on the Administrator of the Department on June 21, 2004, and mailed to the last known addresses of A1 Tech Marketing and Amir Elias, by certified mail, return receipt requested, and delivery restricted.

The Notice specified that failure to request a hearing within fifteen (15) days of service of the Notice would result in the issuance of an order to cease and desist. No request for hearing or any other response has been received by the Administrator within the time limit specified in the Notice.

The Administrator, being fully advised in the premises, hereby finds that this action is necessary and appropriate in the public interest and sets forth the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in support thereof.

Findings of Fact

1. A1 Tech Marketing is a California corporation that, at all times relevant hereto, was doing business in Oklahoma. A1 Tech Marketing is in the business of selling products and services to enable its members to distribute Direct Track, a satellite tracking device installed in automobiles.

2. Amir Elias ("Elias"), a California resident, is the president of A1 Tech Marketing.

3. During November of 2003, an A1 Tech Marketing representative called an Oklahoma resident ("Oklahoma Member") about becoming a member to gain the skills to set up and run a successful distributorship. The sales representative told the Oklahoma Member that A1 Tech Marketing would provide the Oklahoma Member with an advertising coach to assist in promotion of the program and to help reach prospective customers for the Oklahoma Member's business.

4. On November 24, 2003, the Oklahoma Member permitted the sales representative to charge his credit card for a trial money back guaranteed membership with A1 Tech Marketing ("Member Agreement") for which the Oklahoma Member paid \$1,200.

5. The Member Agreement provided that the Oklahoma Member would be responsible for contacting potential purchasers through his own web site and that the Oklahoma Member would be responsible for earning income through his own efforts. The Member Agreement further provided that the Oklahoma Member would receive access to Net Direct Marketing's personal marketing coach ("Coach"). The Coach would help members decide on advertising methods to reach prospective consumers.

6. The Member Agreement is not registered under the Act.

To the extent any of these Findings of Fact should be considered Conclusions of Law, they should be so considered.

Conclusions of Law

1. Effective service of process was made on A1 Tech Marketing and Elias pursuant to Section 818(F) of the Act.

2. The Member Agreements are business opportunities.

3. A1 Tech Marketing and Elias offered and sold a business opportunity in Oklahoma.

4. The offer and sale by A1 Tech Marketing and Elias of the Member Agreements without registration of the Member Agreements under the Act is a violation of Section 806 of the Act.

5. The Administrator has the authority under Section 814 of the Act to order A1 Tech Marketing and Elias to cease and desist from engaging in violations of the Act.

To the extent any of these Conclusions of Law should be considered Findings of Fact, they should be so considered.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A1 Tech Marketing and Elias cease and desist from the offer and sale of business opportunities in this state in violation of Sections 806 and 819 of the Act.
