



- 1) a sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), to be paid every three months beginning on the 30th day of June, 2002, and continuing to and including March 31, 2003.
- 2) a sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), to be paid every three months beginning on the 30th day of June, 2003, and continuing to and including March 31, 2004.
- 3) a sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00), to be paid every three months beginning on the 30th day of June, 2004, and continuing to and including March 31, 2005, or until paid in full.

To date, Max Davis has paid the sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$3,600.00) to [REDACTED]. However, Max Davis has failed to fulfill the terms of the ordered restitution. Max Davis agrees to pay a minimum sum of \$100.00 per month, commencing December 15, 2005, and on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month thereafter, and continuing until paid in full or unless modified by this Court. Davis agrees to provide documentation to the Department evidencing the payments made. In the event that Max Davis is unable to make a payment on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> of any month, he will have ten (10) calendar days to make the payment without penalty. Max Davis agrees that failure to make a required payment will be a violation of the Order of Permanent Injunction and that he will be in contempt of such order.

On or before November 30, 2006, Max Davis agrees to submit to the Department, a financial statement, in the nature of an income statement and balance sheet, as of October 31, 2006.

Therefore, based on the evidence reviewed, the Court finds that the following order should be entered.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Max Davis pay restitution to [REDACTED] in a minimum sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), on a monthly basis, on or

before the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month, commencing on December 15, 2005, and continuing until paid in full or unless modified by this Court. Davis shall provide documentation to the Department evidencing the payments made. In the event that Max Davis is unable to make payment on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of any month, he will have ten (10) calendar days to make the payment without penalty. Failure to make a payment will be a violation of the Order of Permanent Injunction entered herein on January 2, 2002.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before November 30, 2006, Max Davis shall submit to the Department a financial statement, in the nature of an income statement and balance sheet, as of October 31, 2006.


