**UNOPPOSED APPLICATION OF RECEIVER TO CONTINUE  
HEARINGS ON APPLICATIONS**

Receiver, Douglas L. Jackson, makes application to the Court to continue the hearings on his application pending before the Court to establish a procedure to notify claimants to make claims and his interim application for authority to pay interim attorneys fees, both of which are currently set for hearing on February 17, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. In support of this Application, the Receiver would show the Court as follows:

1. The Receiver's Applications as noted above were filed on January 14, 2010, and set for hearing on this Court's February 17, 2010 motion docket.
2. The Receiver has a conflict with the February 17th hearing date, and believes he should be present for these hearings.
3. Counsel for the Receiver has contacted counsel for Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities, and counsel for Intervenors, Christi Roark, Chad Roark and Craig Roark, and is authorized to state that they do not oppose continuing the hearings on Receiver's Applications.
4. Counsel for Intervenors, Christi Roark, Chad Roark, and Craig Roark, further advised that he would request the Interim Application for Attorney Fees and Costs by Intervenor, Christiana Roark, be heard at the same time as the Receiver's two Applications. Counsel for the

Receiver and Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities, have no objection to the hearing on Intervenor's application being continued to the same date.

5. Counsel for the parties of record are agreeable to continuing the hearings on all three pending Applications identified above to February 19, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. and request that the Court enter an order continuing the hearings.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver respectfully request the Court grant this Unopposed Application of Receiver to Continue Hearings on Applications and move or continue the hearings from February 17, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. until February 19, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.


