**DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST DONALD J. WOOD**

This matter came before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, upon the petition of the Plaintiff for a permanent injunction against Donald J. Wood pursuant to Section 406.1 of the Oklahoma Securities Act (the "Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-413, 501, 701-703 (West 2003). The Court, having reviewed the petition, summons, return of service and court file, finds that Defendant Donald J. Wood has been validly

served with petition and summons, that no appearance has been made by said defendant within the time allowed, and no motion or pleading has been filed on his behalf.

Defendant Donald J. Wood is in default and has thus admitted the substantial allegations of the Plaintiff's Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief ("Petition"). It appears to this Court from the facts alleged in the Petition that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief for which it has prayed against Defendant Donald J. Wood.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Donald J. Wood be, and hereby is, permanently enjoined from, directly or indirectly:

1. offering or selling any security in and/or from this state;
2. transacting business in this state as a broker-dealer or agent;
3. making any untrue statements of material fact or omitting to state material facts necessary in order to make statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they are made, not misleading, in connection with the offer, sale, and/or purchase of securities in and/or from this state;
4. engaging in any act, practice, or course of business which operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person; and
5. unlawfully distributing sales literature in and/or from this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Donald J. Wood pay restitution to any and all investors who purchased the securities described in the Petition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a civil penalty payable to the Plaintiff be imposed against Donald J. Wood in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

IT IS SO ORDERED.
