MOTION TO SET ASIDE DEFAULT JUDGMENT

COMES NOW the Defendant, Donald Wood, by and through his attorneys of record, L. Justin Lowe and M. Michael Arnett, moves this Court to set aside the Judgment by Default against Defendant, Donald Wood, taken by the Oklahoma Department of Securities. In support of this motion, Defendant states as follows:

1. Defendant, Donald Wood, did not answer the petition because the EASE Corporation had hired L. Justin Lowe and M. Michael Arnett to represent the corporation.
2. Defendant thought that because the EASE Corporation was represented he did not have to be represented and/or answer personally.

3. Defendant thought he was protected by the corporate veil and could not be subject to lawsuits.

4. Defendant has hired L. Justin Lowe to represent him and answer this petition individually as Donald Wood.

5. Generally default judgments are not preferred by the Supreme Court and the Supreme Court has favored setting aside judgments taken in default.

6. If set aside, Defendant, Donald Wood, will answer said Petition within twenty (20) days of requested order and relief, not prejudicing any time constraints on the rest of Plaintiff's Petition against any and all other Defendants, as no motion to enter has been filed by either side.


