Based upon the argument of counsel and the Court having reviewed all pleadings and submissions of the parties, the Court finds as follows:


1. This Court has nothing to do with the claims of the Receiver filed against the Movants in Oklahoma County;

3. The Court finds that the Movants' Motions to Intervene and Mr. LeBoeuf's Motion to Intervene and Set Aside Order Supporting Receiver and to Transfer and to Consolidate case should be and hereby are denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motions to Intervene filed on behalf of Richard LeBoeuf and Ben Allen, et al., and joined by Janice Fagg, Kathleen Gibson, Ella Carr, Frank and Alice Sue Ward, Todd Ward, Josephine Ward and Chester Weems are **DENIED**.
