**Deadline to Object to Debtor's Discharge or to Challenge Dischargeability of Certain Debts: December 12, 2011**  
**Deadline to Object to Exemptions: Thirty (30) days after the conclusion of the meeting of creditors.**

**Creditors May Not Take Certain Actions**

In most instances, the filing of the bankruptcy case automatically stays certain collection and other actions against the debtor and the debtor's property. Under certain circumstances, the stay may be limited to 30 days or not exist at all, although the debtor can request the court to extend or impose a stay. If you attempt to collect a debt or take other action in violation of the Bankruptcy Code, you may be penalized. Consult a lawyer to determine your rights in this case.
